Cedar Creek Lake -- March 22-23, 2003

Cedar Creek Lake - Some of the most beautiful weather in 20 years of KCKL 95.9 FM BIG BASS TOURNAMENTS greeted contestants and spectators at last weeks anniversary event. Light winds and temperatures ranging from the 50s to the 70s made for some prime conditions for anglers vying for the 140 cash prizes up for grabs. Contestants entered in this year's event came from as far away as Arizona, Virginia, and New York. During the event, anglers weighed in over 400 bass which were then released back into Cedar Creek Lake.

For the 20th Anniversary Tournament, KCKL returned to the location where it all began in 1984 - Sunny Glen Marina at Clear Creek. With the warming water temperatures, over 1,000

fishermen found the big bass moving up into the shallows feeding in preparation for the spring spawn. Most of the bass were caught in shallow coves and pockets using spinnerbaits and lightly weighted plastics such as Senkos and lizards. As has been the case the past few years, the Tournament winning bass has been landed on

the second day of the Tournament. During the Sunday 1-2 o'clock Hour, sixteen year old James R. Milligan, Jr. of Kemp excitedly brought in his 9.26 lb. big bass. James reported catching his fish on an 8 inch plastic worm in 13 feet of water on the south end of the lake. The Tournament winning fish was worth \$7,700 in cash plus a chance for a new 2003 Chevrolet Duramax Diesel Pickup from Teague Chevrolet-Buick of Mabank. Additionally, James received a Special Edition KCKL "Tournament Champion" tackle bag and 20th Annual KCKL Tournament Kistler Graphite Rod.

In total, over 140 cash prizes were paid to the tournament anglers making for quite a few happy people. Especially proud was the 10th Place winner Bobby Willoughby of Lindale. Bobby landed his 10th place bass on a Strike King 3X plastic craw worm to win the \$500 Bonus Cash prize from Strike King.

To encourage family and youth participation, the Tournament offers a special \$10 Entry Fee for those under 16 years of age. This year we had seventy five Youth Division anglers. Additionally, 27 Lady Anglers participated in this year's event.
